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# Is all RAP the Same? Within most RAP piles the aggregates will vary from low skid to high skid, non-polishing aggregates

- Low Skid Low volume traffic, low speed (Residential, County)
- State Routes require high skid, non polishing aggregates (ADT greater than 3000-5000)
- Will require stockpile management and help from Agencies



# **RAP Micro Surfacing**

What is RAP Micro Surfacing and Why is it Becoming More Popular?

- RAP Micro is simply utilizing Reclaimed Asphalt Pavement in place of virgin aggregates
- With the aggregate sources being depleted, there's a need to turn to more sustainable resources

# **RAP Contamination**

- Ensure RAP piles are free of contaminates
- If screening only, make sure the RAP milling are separated from large sawcut pieces of HMA. Large pieces can damage the screens.
- Type of Aggregate

- Mix build-up on spreader box and pugmill
- Single course
- Surface Damage (High Temps)

## 50/50 Blends

- No Compaction
- No additional equipment requiredMinimal material build-up
- Multi-Layers (Heavier application
- rate)
- No Issues w/ high temps

- Emulsion Content was 11.6% (Typically 11.8%-12%)
